

Kindergarten Lesson Plan: Dream Big with Chickity and CluckWerks - Utilizing the book, "Chickity PooPoo and the Pootertoot Wigglysplot Flying Machine."

Duration: 45-60 Minutes

Focus: Listening, creativity, and simple narrative parts.

Objectives:

1. Understand Chickity's dream and journey.

- 2. Identify the moral: persistence, importance of imagination, asking for help, always trying your hardest.
- 3. Create a flying craft using LEGO, art supplies, or drawing.

Materials:

- Copy of Chickity PooPoo and the Pootertoot Wigglysplot Flying Machine.
- Simplified story map (beginning, middle, end).
- LEGO bricks.
- Random art supplies (pipe cleaners, pom-poms, feathers).
- Drawing paper and crayons.
- CluckWerks Builder Certificate template.

Activities:

1. Book Reading (15 Minutes):

- Teacher reads the book aloud, showing illustrations and emphasizing Chickity's dream
- Ask simple comprehension questions like, "What did Chickity want to do?"

1st Grade Lesson Plan: Flying High with Chickity and CluckWerks - Utilizing the book, "Chickity PooPoo and the Pootertoot Wigglysplot Flying Machine."

Duration: 50-60 Minutes

Focus: Story retelling, moral understanding, and creativity.

Objectives:

1. Retell the story using a story map.

- 2. Identify the moral: persistence and teamwork.
- 3. Design a flying craft using LEGO, art supplies, or hand drawings.

Materials:

- Copy of Chickity PooPoo and the Pootertoot Wigglysplot Flying Machine.
- Story map templates.
- LEGO bricks.
- Random art supplies.
- Drawing paper, crayons, and markers.
- CluckWerks Builder Certificate template.

Activities:

- 1. Book Reading (15 Minutes):
 - Read the book aloud and pause to ask, "What do you think will happen next?"

Duration: 55-60 Minutes

Focus: Identifying story parts, moral understanding, and collaborative

creativity.

Objectives:

1. Analyze the story structure (beginning, middle, end).

- 2. Discuss the moral: persistence, asking for help, and teamwork.
- 3. Build and name a creative flying craft.

Materials:

- Copy of Chickity PooPoo and the Pootertoot Wigglysplot Flying Machine.
- Story structure charts.
- LEGO bricks.
- Random art supplies.
- Drawing paper and colored pencils.
- CluckWerks Builder Certificate template.

Activities:

- 1. Book Reading (15 Minutes):
 - Read aloud and encourage students to summarize each part of the story.

Duration: 60 Minutes

Focus: Detailed story analysis, moral exploration, and imaginative creation.

Objectives:

1. Explore the story's themes and narrative structure.

- 2. Understand the value of teamwork and persistence.
- 3. Build a flying craft collaboratively and creatively.

Materials:
